Check-In Time

Check in time is **4:00 pm or later** on the date of your arrival.

Check-Out Time

Check out time is **noon or earlier** on the date of your departure. Please leave dishes clean, one load of laundry started, bedding bundled on top of bed, replace furniture to its original location and trash taken outside to the garbage receptacles.

Linens and Towels

All linens and towels are provided. There is one set of sheets for every bed and 2 towels for every person. Most homes have a washer and dryer should you need to do laundry.

Telephone Use

Most homes have a telephone will provide for local phone calls only. Most cell phones work in our area.

Pets

See the pet policy in your contract – an extra fee and reporting of your pet is required. Please clean up after your pet both inside and outside.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any of the homes. If you do smoke please step outside and be sure that all materials are thoroughly extinguished and disposed of.

Cleaning Service

Cleaning Service is not provided during your stay but can be arranged at your request. Upon check-out please leave dishes clean, bedding bundled on top of bed, replace furniture to its original location and trash taken outside to the garbage receptacles.

Septic System

Please be reminded that this house is on a septic system. It is very important that you do not flush anything down the toilet other than toilet paper. Please put all feminine products in the garbage.

Possible unsuitable conditions

Possible unsuitable conditions for children may exist at the house. Please supervise your children at all times. This home may be located on medium or high bluff and close to water. There may be potentially slippery decks or rocks or other conditions.

Shellfish

You may take shellfish from the beach in front of the house and according to the Washington State fish & game regulations which are supplied at the house. **A license, even for private beach, is required.**

Quiet Time

Please be respectful of the neighbors. Quiet time during the late night hours starts at 10pm. The neighbors are advised to call us if there is a problem. They have also been instructed to call the sheriff.

Boats

Boats and kayaks are not part of the amenities of this house. You can rent them from the marina and Kayak rentals, *see Links to our Area.*

Power Outages
